Student Council (STUCO) Election Procedures

2023-2024

St. Rocco School Student Council provides students with the opportunity to be involved and lead events planned by the Council. All members of Student Council must be available for meetings. The meetings are held every other Tuesday morning at 7:40AM.

A nomination form is sent home and students have to make note of the office sought and return completed form to school.

Due to COVID, the standard of having one year of experience has been omitted for the 2022-2023 school year.

Students entering 8^{th} grade and with one year of STUCO experience may run for President and Vice President. Students entering 8^{th} and 7^{th} grade may run for Secretary, Treasurer, Public Relations and Class Representative. Students entering 6^{th} grade may only run for Class Representative.

Duties of Office

President oversees the meetings and delegates assignments to members of the Student Council.

Vice President assists the President and holds the meeting in the Presidents absence.

Secretary transcribes accurate notes and attendance during the meetings.

Public Relations conduct the morning/afternoon prayers ~announcements and need to be at SCHOOL by 8:10am and be prepared for class.

Class Representative/s are the liaisons between Middle School homerooms and Student Council.

Executive Appointees may be selected after elections from the remaining candidates by teachers and the Principal. Factors taken into consideration may be the student's speech and leadership abilities.

***All the above positions may be asked to volunteer and assist Student Council in any way. ***

Procedures for Voting (These may be altered due to COVID restrictions.)

- 1. Once all nomination forms are received and have been approved by the teachers and the Principal, students will be notified and their name will be placed on the ballot.
- 2. Students may display posters in designated areas throughout the school, however, no food, candy, pins or stickers are allowed.
- 3. The elections are ballot voting and will be held in Café Rocco. Students need to prepare a speech to include an introduction and why they wish to hold office.
- 4. Announcements of the winners will be made at the conclusion of voting.
- 5. The Class Representative election will be held in the individual homerooms following perspective Class Representative Speeches.
