

Admissions Procedures 2024-2025

Necessary Documents Prior to Admission

- **♥** Application
- **♥** Certificate of Birth
- **♥** Baptismal Certificate
- ♥ Progress report and the most recent report card
- ◆ A written recommendation from current teacher or principal (for entering Grades K-7)
- **♥** Most resent standardized test
- ▼ An up-to-date immunization record
- If applicable: Custody paperwork ~ Educational Plan

Admission Procedure

- ♥ All necessary documents must be received by the school.
- ▼ Interview of parent and student/s entering Grades K~7 by the principal.
- ♥ The Learning Specialist will administer a screening of the applicant.
- ▶ All students entering Grades K-7 are invited to be our guest for partial/entire day, which will provide the teachers the opportunity to observe the applicant in the school setting.
- Parents have agreed to have their child be educated in the Catholic faith and the practices of our Faith.

Child Outreach Information (K only)

To make sure the student/s are ready to begin the kindergarten program, we are asking that each parent have an initial screening through the free "Child Outreach" program in their own town. Parents, please provide the results to St. Rocco School. Our Kindergarten teachers will also do additional observational screening when school begins in the fall.

Johnston – Please look in the Providence Journal and the Sun Rise the last two weeks of January for information regarding child screening.

Cranston – **Child Outreach** takes place from September through May.

Selection of Applicants

- ▶ A complete application must be submitted to the school for review and acceptance.
- ♥ Successful applicants will be accepted in the following priority order:
 Siblings ~ St. Rocco Church Parishioners ~ Other
- ▶ All acceptances to St. Rocco School (every grade level) are conditional. Comprehensive school documentation is necessary to help determine appropriate placement for the students.
- ♥ All applicants will be notified by mail and/or phone call of the decision on the application.
- Once a student is accepted to St. Rocco School, non-compliance with parents'/guardians' commitment may result in referring the child to an alternate educational environment.
- ♥ St. Rocco School does not discriminate on the basis of race, color, gender, nationality or ethnic origin.
