Dear Parents,

Catholic Schools' Week begins this Sunday with the opening Mass at 10:00 a.m. Our students who are altar servers and who are in the Student Council, Honor Society, and Choir will be taking part in this special Mass. The recipients of the David M. DeCosta Scholarship will be recognized during the liturgy as well. Mass will be followed by an Open House 11:00-1:00pm with refreshments, tours, and the opening of the Book Fair. Seventh Grade will have their inventions from the "Invention Convention" on display and classrooms will be open with student work displayed. This is the first time in several years that we have been able to open the school to both our current and prospective families. We are really hoping for a wonderful turn-out for Mass and at our Open House. All are welcome!

Some background on Catholic Schools' Week:

Fifty years ago, in 1974, Catholic Schools Week was established by the National Catholic Education Association as an opportunity to celebrate the value of Catholic education, not just to the Church, but to society as a whole. "I remember that first Catholic Schools Week well. At the time, I was teaching literature and religion to 7th and 8th graders, directing the school's plays, coaching girls' basketball, and serving as a substitute cheerleading moderator and Girl Scout leader. In those days, like today, everyone who taught or worked in a Catholic School pitched in and took responsibility for all aspects of the school's life and culture. We worked together to ensure that the Catholic school experience was---for each member of the community---an education for life."

The above excerpt (that I share each year!) was taken from an article written by one of my previous Catholic School teachers. I was one of those 7th Graders on the basketball team, in the school play and sitting in that ELA classroom. While I did not know at the time that being an educator in a Catholic School would be my vocation, I did know that there was something very special about going to a Catholic School. Today I know that it is not just something special, but everything special. While education has changed tremendously since 1974, the Faith, respect and nurturing environment in Catholic Schools has remained the same. St. Rocco School is more than just a school. It is a home away from home for our students to return to long after they graduate.

Along with the opening of Catholic Schools' Week Mass this Sunday, it is also the beginning of open registration for the 2024-25 school year. If you have not had your interview and re-registered, please call the office to arrange this. If you know of someone who is interested in attending St. Rocco School, now would be

the time for them to inquire and schedule a tour. We will continue with our Referral Program this year. Please see the attached letter outlining this program. Basically, by referring someone who registers for St. Rocco School, you can earn a monetary or tuition credit of either \$250 or \$500 off next year's tuition if they remain an active student through December.

Last week a hard copy flyer was sent home in the Thursday Packet describing all the activities that will be taking place next week as we celebrate our school community and Catholic faith. A copy of these activities is being sent again as an attachment. First up on Monday is Career Day, an opportunity for all students to "dress as their career" and share their career hopes with their classmates and Faith Buddies. Students should come to school dressed in the dress of their career.

- Please be reminded that all families re-applying for next year must complete the online *FACTS Grant and Aid* form each year.
- The Diocese of Providence will use this information to determine your family's need. As soon as you have received your 2017 W-2 wage statement from your employer, please fill out the *FACTS* form. If you have not completed your 2023 income tax return, you may use your 2022 income tax return and your 2022 & 2023 W-2 statements together to file the *FACTS Grant and Aid* form.
