- New Applications for 2024-25: Tell family and friends to come and visit and tour our school on January 28th at our Open House. - Re-Registration for 2024-25: Re-registration will take place the week of January 17th-26th. Appointments were scheduled and sent home with your child last week. Tuition must to be current to re-register.
- Please be reminded that all families re-applying for next year must complete the online *FACTS Grant and Aid* form each year.
- The Diocese of Providence will use this information to determine your family's need. As soon as you have received your 2017 W-2 wage statement from your employer, please fill out the *FACTS* form. If you have not completed your 2023 income tax return, you may use your 2022 income tax return and your 2022 & 2023 W-2 statements together to file the *FACTS Grant and Aid* form.

I am very proud and excited to say the children have done nothing but flourish in Spanish. In grades 4 and 5, students are learning a variety of Spanish songs and activities that relate to subjects like: common expressions, body parts, family members, months, days of the week, seasons, and so much more. Students will also have the opportunity to practice these new words through creating their own riddles, songs and games. A student favorite game, "Simon Says" is back. It's a race to see who can listen and act when Simon commands. We will squeeze in some number practice by playing a ball tossing game, it's all about counting as high as we can before the ball drops.

Topics are introduced in early grades and built upon each year, therefore, in grades 6-8, we will be working on written expressions along with how to conjugate verbs. This will help with the ability to formulate and process complete sentences. We will be giving personal characteristics to ourselves and friends using the verb ser and adding adjectives to formulate sentences. To demonstrate their learning, students will be creating superheroes or super villains attached with a writing portion.

Language is a gateway to understanding culture and boy did Seventh Grade succeed! During the month of November, the whole school came to watch Grade 7 bring Dia de los Muertos to life.
