Dear Parents,

Advent is a time of light and preparation. The second purple candle that we light this Sunday stands for the virtue of love. This visual of two candles lit tells us we are getting closer to Christmas, but that we still have time to prepare our hearts for Christ's coming. What are we doing to "prepare the way of the Lord"?



Last week at our First Friday Mass, Fr. Carusi spoke to the students about preparing during Advent to receive Jesus into their lives this Christmas. Within the St. Rocco School community, we are preparing with daily Advent prayers, collecting food, dressing down for Adopt-a Family and "Keep the Heat On", and making cards and Advent chains. The school, church and convent are aglow with lights. And all our students are practicing with Mrs. Rachdouni as she prepares them for this year's Christmas Concerts.

Tomorrow our school community will attend Mass for the Feast of the Immaculate Conception, the day the Catholic Church recognizes the sinless conception of Mary, nine months before the feast of the Nativity of Mary, celebrated on September 8<sup>th</sup>. #### Grade 5 – ELA – Mrs. Lisa Scotti

In Fifth Grade English, we are very busy reading in Literature, writing with proper grammar in ELA and learning impressive vocabulary in Spelling.





We have progressed through Nouns in ELA/Grammar and have begun to touch on Pronouns. Grammar provides a solid basis for the children to express themselves, and they can't be good writers or speakers without it!



In Reading, our new reading series has challenged us to dig deeper to find thoughts, feelings, and solid text evidence within each story. We have begun working on story elements; the children are learning that sometimes the message behind the story can be different for each reader but still correct if they can support it with story evidence.



All in all, Fifth Grade is learning and growing every day. Their curiosity is amazing, and I look forward to watching them mature as they head toward the second half of the year!

### Middle School Math - Gr. 6-8 - Mr. James Tully

Grade Seven will be finishing rational numbers concentrating on decimal operations in an algebraic context. Upon their return they will delve into rational numbers and factoring.

Finally, our Grade Eight class will finish the calendar year by completing algebraic inequalities. They will kick off the new year with polynomials and factoring.


