Reminders/Housekeeping



**IF YOUR CHILD IS NOT FEELING WELL, please keep them home and call or email the SCHOOL OFFICE FIRST to report them absent. You may send an email to your child's teacher and to the nurse, but initially, the phone call/email must be to the School Office first. Please DO NOT send a notification of absence through Class Dojo. If you are unsure if you should send your child to school, call the office to speak to the nurse. Please contact the Nurse with any questions.

Please call to notify the School Office by 8:30AM if your child will be absent. If your child is going to be late and will be ordering school lunch, please call the School Office no later than 8:30AM so we can plan accordingly. PLEASE DO NOT NOTIFY THE TEACHER THROUGH CLASS DOJO IF YOUR CHILD IS SICK.

Student Data/Custody Concerns – Please notify the School Office if any information regarding your child has changed since the submission of your child's application for enrollment. Any custody concerns require immediate notification to the School Office.

<u>DRESS CODE</u>: – We take pride in the appearance of our students. The way a student dresses and appears often influences behavior and learning. Uniforms must be worn at all times unless it is a casual "Dress Down Day". Please refer to the School Handbook available on the School Website.

<u>DRESS DOWN DAY POLICY/MONTHLY PASSES</u> ~ Each month throughout the school year, beginning in October, St. Rocco School will be offering special dress down passes for the month. You may purchase the monthly passes for November for the cost of \$5.00. The "Dress Down Day" passes are for **Tuesdays only**. Please place the money in a clearly labeled envelope with the required form, your child's name and grade, along with your payment. (Checks ONLY). There will also be days designated as a *Dress Down Day* for charities, celebrations, recognitions, etc. Please check the monthly calendars as these days will be noted. *We NO LONGER give dress down passes. We just record your child's name and month(s) they paid for dress down.

Reduced and Free lunch: Anyone wishing to apply or feels they may qualify, please fill out an application and submit it the school office.

Just a friendly reminder: If you received free or reduced lunch last year, a new application has to be submitted again this year. If one is not received, your benefits will end as of October 9th. The applications for Free and Reduced Lunch are available online on the School Website. Please call the office if you need a hard copy. Applications are accepted all year long.

*IMPORTANT** Any payment sent in for your child MUST BE IN AN ENVELOPE, CLEARLY LABELED WITH:

- Student's Name
- Student's Homeroom
- Indicate what payment is for
- Lunch Choices if applicable

KINDERGARTEN A – MRS. LISA SCOTTI

Happy October! Kindergarten A has been very busy and we're so happy the weather has been beautiful, giving us more outside time! We are learning the rules of kindergarten and garnering some privileges when we do what we're supposed to do.

Tying autumn together with God the Father, Jesus the Son and the Holy Spirit has been a major focus in our classroom. We used apples to understand the three-in-one nature of God: the apple peel represents God the Father, the inside of the apple, the "flesh", represents Jesus, and the seeds are the Holy Spirit, from which our faith grows.

KA expanded our Fall lessons to include the growth cycle of apples, as well as beans, gourds and pumpkins. We cut into them and handled the seeds, and when we cut our apple across, we found that God put a star inside, with five points to remind us of the five wounds of Jesus!

The children are making great strides with their Sight Words, and we can already read some rudimentary sentences using those words! Before long, we will be using our primary books to learn the rhythm and cadence of words and sentences.

Also, the children are excelling at Kindergarten Math. They are working on more complicated shapes like hexagons and parallelograms and figuring out grouping and the many different ways to make shapes using other shapes.

Together, we are really making an effort to grow into Kindergarteners. In fact, we have already learned to pray at the end of lunch, instead of going back to class early while the older grades say prayer! Getting along with each other, problem solving with peers and not shouting out are skills that we're mastering.

Keep an eye on us, because we are growing in leaps and strides!


