# Lunch/Snack Shop Program

The procedure for ordering/purchasing a hot/cold lunch:

- The cost for lunch is **\$3.60**.
- Lunches are to be ordered in the homeroom by the student each morning
- The **exact** amount (very helpful) is to be put in an envelope clearly marked with your child's name and homeroom number on it. (Grades PK3 -8)
- A lunch menu calendar will be sent home each month attached to the Weekly Parent Letter and is also posted on our school website.
- If your child orders regularly, they may prepay for lunch for the week.
- You must be specific when indicating the days you are purchasing lunch. (Sorry, no IOU's.) However, no child will ever go without a lunch.
- If your child will be late, please call in their lunch choice to the school office by 8:45am.
