News from 4th grade...



The fourth-grade students continue to learn and grow every day here at St. Rocco School. In Religion the students are learning about the Commandments as well as Lent, The Triduum and Easter. Students are reminded that we honor God by believing in Him, praying to Him, worshiping Him and loving others. On March 27th, fourth grade will be presenting The Living Stations of The Cross. This portrayal of the journey of Jesus to Calvary is a beautiful and touching reminder of the last hours of Jesus' life and God's immense love for us.



In Math students are working on fractions. They are learning how to add and subtract fractions, compare, and order fractions, simplify improper fractions, and solve word problems. In Reading students continue to challenge themselves with works of fiction, as well as informational texts. They have recently finished reading the chapter book, Shiloh, and have had wonderful discussions about themes such as determining right from wrong and the importance of family and friends.

In Science students are learning about the earth and will begin a Rocks and Minerals unit. We will be using our Foss kits and breaking "mock" rocks apart like real geologists to see what they are made of. Students will test the rocks for hardness and calcite.

In Social Studies fourth grade continues to study the 50 states. Each student will be assigned to a state to research for a State Fair Project. Students will write letters to the Chamber of Commerce in each of their states requesting information. They love receiving mail! They will also research foods, fun facts, geographical features, and famous people from their state. Students' State Fair projects will be on display for parents and school children in May. Fourth grade is a year of transition and growth. Students are learning to study, plan their time, and become more independent. These students are up for the challenge!
