Dear Parents,

- distinguish fact/fantasy, sequence events in a story

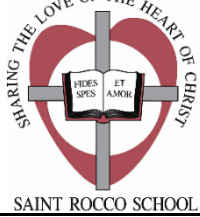

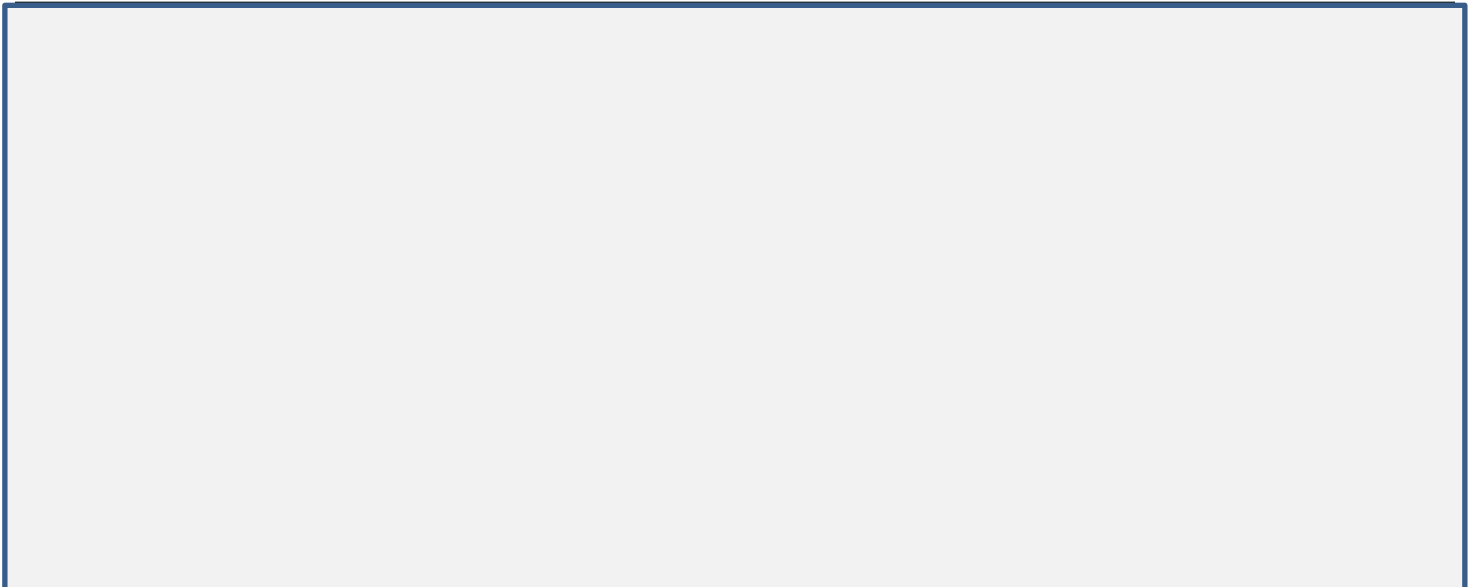
