



Eligibility Requirements

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Students in grades 6–8 who meet the requirements for membership outlined in the guidelines listed below set forth by St. Rocco School are eligible to be invited for membership.

For students in sixth and seventh grade, consideration for induction for the following school year will take place after the completion of the second trimester grading period. Each chapter is required to publish its qualifications for membership, which is based on the five pillars of SRSHS:

- **Scholarship**
Per SRS guidelines, students must achieve a minimum of a cumulative grade of 90% or above in their academic subjects. Please refer to Grading/Weighting/Honors/St. Rocco School Honor Society Policies Guides available on the school website listed under the Academics Tab for a more detailed explanation.
 - **Service**
This involves voluntary contributions made by a student to the school or community, done without compensation.
 - **Leadership**
Student leaders are those who are resourceful, good problem solvers, and idea contributors. Leadership experiences can be drawn from school or community activities while working with or for others.
 - **Character**
The student of good character is cooperative; demonstrates high standards of honesty and reliability; shows courtesy, concern, and respect for others; and generally maintains a clean disciplinary record.
 - **Citizenship**
The student who demonstrates citizenship understands the importance of civic engagement; has a high regard for freedom and justice; respects the U.S. form of government (a representative democracy); respects the law for all citizens at the local, state, and federal levels; and demonstrates mature participation and responsibility in activities such as scouting, community organizations, or school clubs.
